

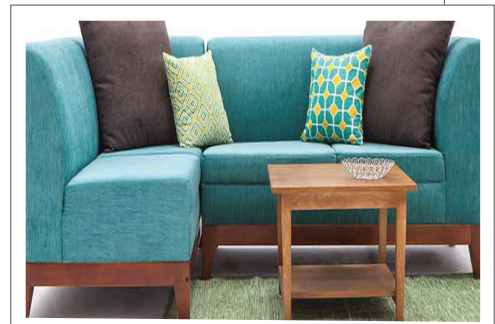
Conditions for donating clothing

- 1- The clothes must be usable.
- 2- The clothes must be good and clean.
- 3- They must be complete pieces (for example: put two pairs of shoes together).
- 4- It must be free of private possessions such as (emptying bags and pockets of clothes from papers and money).
- 5- Clothes should not be stored in black bags (such as garbage bags).



Conditions for donating furniture

- 1- Furniture must be good and reusable.
- 2- It must be in good condition and clean.
- 3- It must be complete, unbroken and undamaged.

GUIDELINES FOR ACCEPTANCE OF FOOD MATERIALS

HOTELS

Description	Condition
Food Materials 	- Accept food materials under proper environmental conditions: a)  Cooked food at a temperature above 63°C. (If below 63°C, maximum of two hours). b)  Sliced vegetables & fruits kept at 4°C or less. c)  Milk & Milk products kept at 4°C or less or frozen (-18°C). d)  Meat & Meat products kept at 4°C or less or frozen (-18°C). - Do not accept Salads. - Do not accept slightly cracked eggs.
 Minimum Quantity	Greater than 50 meals.
 Turn Around Time(TAT)	30- 45 minutes.
 Packed & Canned Items	- Should have expiry greater than 3 months. - See attached Annexure 01 also.
 Packing materials	Food grade packing material/ clean utensils.

HOME

 Food Materials	- Accept foods under proper environmental conditions. - Accept un touchable items. - Accept packed/ covered items.
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Bagged and Sacked Food Containers



If in doubt, Discard them!

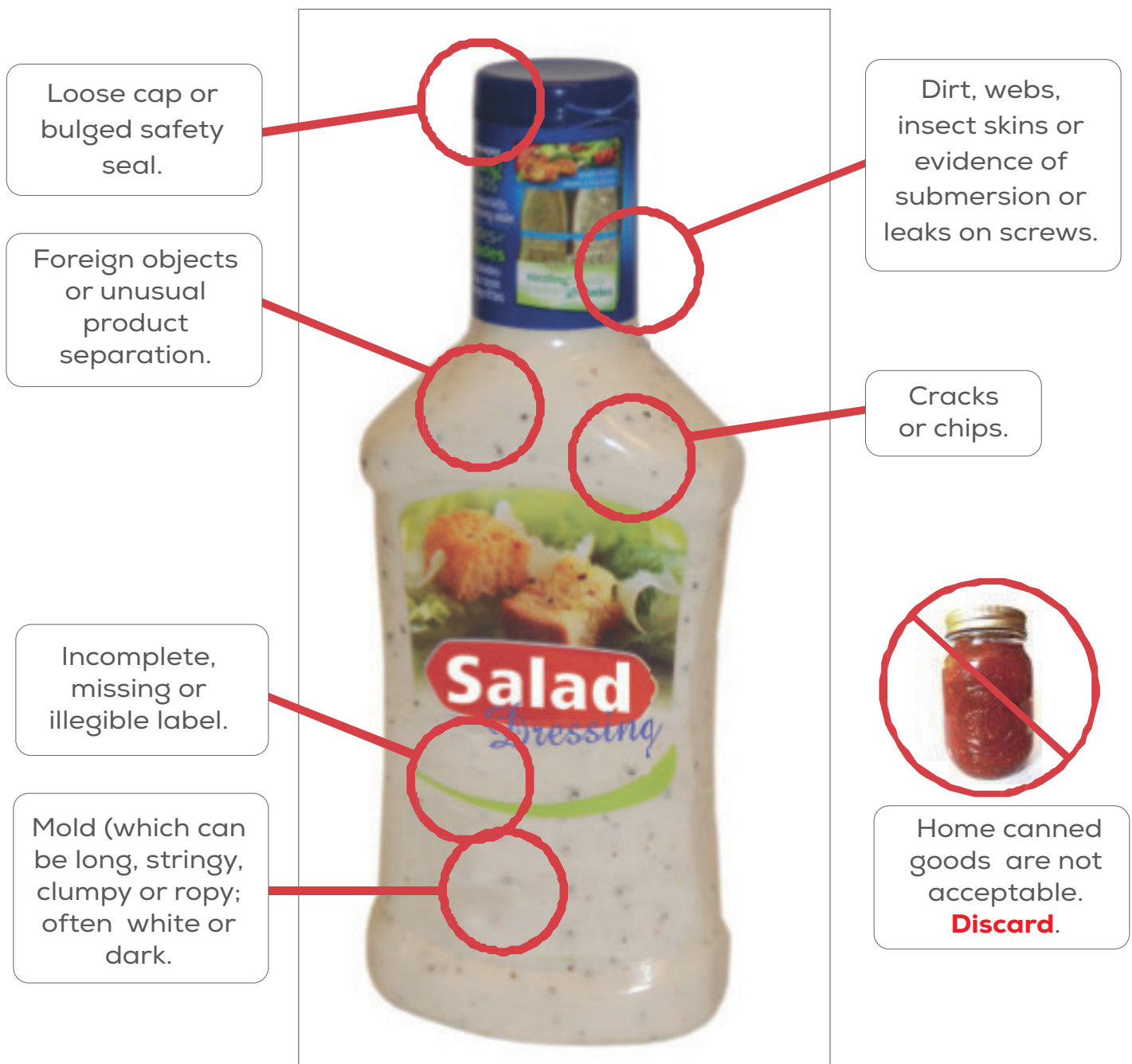
Boxed and Dry Packaged Containers

Discard if any of the following are found:

- 1.** Box is already opened.
- 2.** Insects, insect skins, webs, chaff or moving pieces can be seen
- 3.** Box is torn, leaking, or contaminated
- 4.** Seals are imperfect
- 5.** Mouldy or foreign objects are inside



Glass or Plastic Food Containers



If in doubt, Discard them!

Serious Can Defects

Dented at
junction of
side and
end.



Sharp
dent or
dent on
seam.



Swollen or
bulging.



Pitted rust
or leaking.



**Cans with any of these defects may be unsafe.
Discard them!**

Serious Jar Defects

Inner seal or tamper resistant tape missing or broken.



Dirt under the rim.



Crooked lid, vacuum button raised, other evidence that cap has been opened.



Leaking, crack or chips, or product discolored.
